5-3-1 PURPOSE . The purpose of this chapter is to facilitate the enjoyment of park facilities by the general public by establishing rules and regulations governing the use of park facilities.

5-3-2 USE OF DRIVES REQUIRED. No person shall drive any car, cycle or other vehicle, or ride or drive any horse, in any portion of a park except upon the established drives or roadways therein or such other places as may be officially designated by the City.

5-3-3 FIRES. No fires shall be built, except in a place provided therefor, and such fire shall be extinguished before leaving the area unless it is to be immediately used by some other party.

5-3-4 LITTERING. No person shall place, deposit, or throw any waste, refuse, litter or foreign substance in any area or receptacle except those provided for that purpose.

5-3-5 CAMPING. It shall be lawful for any person to camp within the designated camping areas in the City Park during camping season decide by the Park Board. Fees shall be set by resolution upon recommendation of the Park Board. Fees shall be collected by the Park Board.

5-3-6 PARKS CLOSED. No person that is not involved in camping shall enter or remain within any park between the hours of eleven o'clock (11:00) P.M. and seven o'clock (7:00) A.M.

5-3-7 MAINTENANCE OF NATURAL STATE OF PARK. The north one-half of the present city park shall be maintained in a semi-natural state. No vegetation or trees shall be cleared without written consent of the Park Board. No building or structures of any type shall be erected without the approval of the City Council by a majority vote.

5-3-8 USE OF DUMP STATION IN PARK. Only users of park facilities, having paid fees for the use of the park facilities shall be allowed to utilize the dump station facilities. Persons that wish to utilize the dump station for waste disposal shall get permission from the City Council based on a recommendation of the Superintendent of Public Works and Utilities and shall pay a fee as determined to be reasonable by the City Council and the Superintendent. Failure to receive Council Approval shall be a violation and result in penalties according to Title I, Chapter 3.
